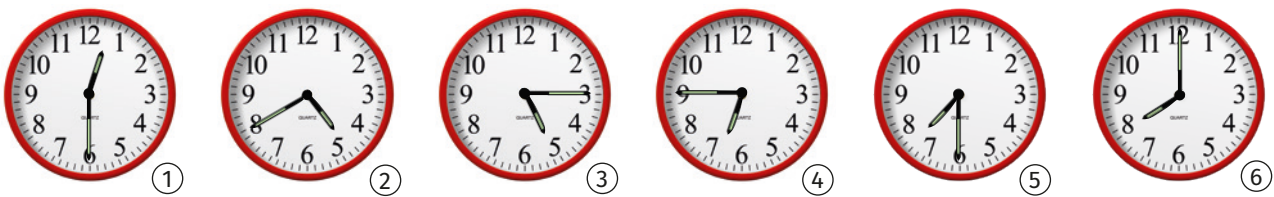

The first month of the experiment was difficult, says Ken (38). They discovered that they couldn't buy much food from their normal supermarket anymore, because almost everything came in plastic packaging: meat, bread and even vegetables.

The family now shop at a farmers' market, although this is very expensive. "It makes you think more about what you are buying," says Ken. "Am I really going to eat that? And how much do I really need? We've also changed what we eat – we used to have meat every day!"

A lot of their plastic waste now comes from their young son's snacks; he loves yoghurt!

Things like shampoo, soap and toothpaste are also a problem, because they all come in plastic packaging. "We could make our own shampoo and soap from things in the kitchen," Hannah says.

"But I haven't had time to try that yet. And sometimes you just want a relaxing bath!"

But Hannah and Ken do make their own cleaning spray from vinegar and dish soap. "It's much better than cleaners from the shops!" says Ken. "I wish I had known earlier!"
