## Word domino

### Teacher's Notes

#### Preparation:

Copy one sheet for every four or five learners. Put the sheet on a piece of cardboard or laminate it. Then cut out the domino cards.

#### In class:

Explain that the groups are supposed to put cards together to make compound words. Give each group a set of cards and explain the rules. Each player gets three cards. The rest of the cards are put on the table face down. The players turn up one card to start with. One player begins by adding on to the left or to the right of the cards on the table. If a player cannot play a card, he must draw one from the "fish" pile. The game continues until a player has got rid of all his or her cards.

Don't be too strict about the rules. Encourage learners to be creative, to play with words. They might come up with funny combinations, like "tomato shake". The aim of the game is to give learners confidence and to show them how many English words they know.
